Marla's Kitchen **Breakfast Enchiladas** (Great for a Easter Brunch or Cinco de Mayo)

Ingredients:

2 cups diced cooked ham 8 green onions, finely sliced (extra for topping) 2 cups or 8 ounces shredded cheddar cheese 10 eight-inch flour tortillas 6 eggs 2 cups half-and-half

1 tablespoon all-purpose flour

1/2 teaspoon kosher salt

Salsa and Sour Cream (optional)



Instructions:

Lightly spray 13x9-inch (3 quart) glass baking dish with cooking spray.

In large bowl, stir together ham, green onions and 1 cup of the cheese. Place 1/3 cup of the ham mixture down the center of each tortilla; roll up and place seam side down in baking dish.

In large bowl, whisk eggs, half-and-half, flour and the salt. Pour over the tortillas. Cover then bake or refrigerate overnight to be baked in the morning.

Heat oven to 350 degrees. If made ahead of time, uncover baking dish. Scatter the remaining cup of cheese over enchiladas. Cover baking dish with aluminum foil and bake for 35 minutes. Uncover, and then bake 10 to 15 minutes longer or until set and cheese melted.

Top with finely sliced green onions, salsa and sour cream.

TODD'S HVAC TIPS

Top Ways to Diagnose Indoor Air Quality Problems

When you think of air pollution, you probably immediately jump to thoughts of traffic and smog. However, the air we breathe indoors is much more likely to contribute to health problems. We spend more time indoors than generations before us. Likewise, modern homes are airtight, leaving allergens trapped inside.



Most Common Indoor Pollutants

Before you can take action to clean your air, you first need to understand your enemies. Here are the most common indoor pollutants:

- **Dust Mites** These microscopic critters (most common cause of allergies found in dust) thrive on humidity.
- Mold Fungus that thrives on the presence of water is called mold. Some forms are deadly.
- Pet Dander Even if you don't have a pet, you'd be surprised how easy pet dander travels. Owners pick it up on their clothes and distribute it throughout the day. Children come from school, and parents return from work.
- Chemicals Paint, wallpaper, cleaning products and more, chemical contaminants can be highly concentrated in homes with inadequate ventilation.

Inspecting for Common Pollutants

Now that you know what commonly causes problems, here are some things you can do to narrow down air quality issues in your home:

- **Dust Mites** Eliminate unnecessary horizontal surfaces. These include bookshelves, knick-knack displays, TV stands and cabinets. Every horizontal surface creates space for dust to settle where you sleep. Consider a dehumidifier to kill dust mites that die without enough humidity. Clean carpets and upholstery thoroughly.
- Mold Check under refrigerators, carpet, near the water heater, under sinks and anywhere else water or plumbing may be present. Roof damage or leaky window seals can also lead to mold growth.
- Pet Dander Consider installing air purifiers. Also, check for the presence of rodents, squirrels and mice.
- Chemicals You won't be able to visibly inspect. Special equipment is needed to detect the presence of chemicals like carbon monoxide, radon gas, nitrogen dioxide and others. You'll need a professional.

JASON'S FYI

Spring Cleaning Safety Hazards

Cleansers

Read the safety labels on cleansers. Never leave cleansers, pesticides or herbicides where children or pets can reach them. If they have expired labels, throw them out. Wear protective eye and hand covering like goggles and rubber gloves. Make sure you have proper ventilation.

Clutter and Cords

Keep floors, stairwells, entryways and landings free of clutter when cleaning and reorganizing. Keep a trash bag and recycling bin handy for garbage as you move from one area to another. Have a clean box for items you plan to donate. Check phone and electric cords. Tuck behind furniture, away from foot traffic. Bundle excess cord using electrical tape or twist ties.

Ladders and Climbing

Stand below the safe level for a ladder or stepladder. On extension ladders, that level is the fourth rung from the top. For a stepladder, it's the second rung from the top. Use the 4 to 1 rule, i.e., place the bottom of the ladder 1 foot away from the wall for every 4 feet of ladder height.

Carrying and Lifting

Bend at the knee when lifting. Moving heavy items incorrectly causes a variety of injuries, particularly to the back. Pace yourself to avoid muscle strain and get help for large items. If you have a lot of heavy lifting, consider getting a back brace for support.

Power Tools

Inspect power tools, particularly electrical cords. Replace any frayed cords. Always follow the manufacturer instructions when using your power tools. Make sure guards are in place on all power tools. Keep children and pets clear while in use. Avoid clothing that could catch in power tools accidentally. Store gasoline for tools in safe container.
